

Notice of Race

50th 12 Foot Skiff Interdominions

1. Date:

The regatta will be conducted from the Saturday the 9th January 2010 to Sunday the 17th January.

Organizing Authority: The Auckland Sailing Club (ASC).

Venue: The Landing Okahu Bay.

2. Rules

The regatta shall be governed by the current rules as defined in the RRS 2009-2012, the prescriptions of the NZYF and by the Sailing Instructions.

3. Eligibility and Entry

The regatta is open to all 12ft Skiffs. Eligible boats may enter the regatta by completing the official entry form available from the ASC prior to racing commencing.

Entries will be accepted during registration times listed below. A fee of NZ\$250 must accompany all entries.

The schedule is a guide to the racing program. The Race Officer reserves the right to alter the program to endeavour to achieve a 10 race regatta should weather or other circumstance prevent.

5. Measurement

Random measurement checks may be carried out at any time during the regatta at the discretion of the race committee.

6. Sailing instructions

The sailing instructions will be available at Auckland sailing club from Friday 8th April and will be handed out with acceptance of entry.

7. Racing Area

The racing area will be on Auckland Harbour. The courses will be described in the sailing instructions and will consist of both laid windward leeward courses and harbour courses.

9. Scoring

The low points scoring system will be used

Five races are required to constitute a series.

When fewer than six races have been completed, a skiff's score will be the total of her race scores.

Where six or more races have been completed, a skiff's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

Where eight or more races have been completed, a skiff's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

9. Prizes

To be advised at time of registration.

10. Penalty System

Rule 44.1 is changed so that the two-penalty turns is replaced with one-turn penalty

11. Protests

Protests will incur a \$50 fee regardless of result.

Protests will first go to mediation before going to a formal protest hearing. Mediators will consist of two representatives from the NZ team and two representatives from the Australian team. No mediators will be involved in the pending protest or be witness to provide evidence in the pending protest hearing.

12. Disclaimer

It is the competitor's decision to enter the event or start and continue in any race. Competitors shall accept that their participation in an event is at their exclusive risk in every respect. See rule 4, decision to race.

The organizing authority and affiliates, their officers, members, employees and agents accept no responsibility in respect to loss of life, personal injury or loss or damage to property which may be sustained by reasons of their participation in this event or however arising in connection with the event.

13. General
