1 DATES

The regatta will be conducted from Thursday 6 January 2011 to Saturday 15 January 2011.

An Invitation handicap event will be held within these dates and it is anticipated there will be two lay days.

2 ORGANISING AUTHORITY

The organising authority is the Lane Cove 12 Foot Sailing Skiff Club (LC12'SSC)

4 RACING AREA

Races will be conducted on the waters of Sydney Harbour in the area between Goat Island and Gladesville Bridge. Courses will be described in the Sailing Instructions.

5 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-12*, the *Prescriptions and Special Regulations Part 2 of Yachting Australia* and by the *Sailing Instructions*.

6 ADVERTISING

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority

7 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

7.1 The regatta is open to all 12 Foot Skiffs

7.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form (see attachment 1) and sending it to the secretary of the organising committee by no later than 20th December 2010

7.3 Late entries will be accepted although will incur a late fee

8 FEES

Entry fees include tickets to welcome, reunion and presentation for both skipper and crew and are payable no later than Thursday 6 January 2011

8.1 Entry fee is AUD 200

8.2 Late entry fee is AUD 250

9 MEASUREMENTS

It is the competitor's responsibility to ensure that their boat and equipment comply with the class rules. Measurement and clothing check may be carried out at any time.

10 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available upon registration.

11 SCORING

11.1 Appendix A the Low Point System will be used

11.2 Five (5) races are required to constitute a series

11.3 When fewer than six (6) races have been completed, a skiff's series score will be the total of her race scores

11.4 When six (6) or seven (7) races have been completed, a skiff's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score

11.5 When eight (8) or more races have been completed, a skiff's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst two (2) scores

12 PENALTY SYSTEM

Rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns penalty is replaced by the One-Turn penalty.

13 PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows:

13.1 Interdominion Championship 1st, 2nd and 3rd

13.2 Veterans 1st

13.3 Juniors 1st

13.4 Interdominion Handicap 1st, 2nd and 3rd

14 DISCLAIMER OF ENTRY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
